

Question 15:

We are planning to register for Hydro-Quebec Distribution Call for Tenders A/O 2009-02. If we are going to bid under different company names, (e.g. Company A is owned by Company XYZ and bids for community project 1 (25MW), Company B is also owned by Company XYZ and bids for community project 2 (another 25MW), and so on) do we need to submit separate Registration Forms for each Company A, B or can we just submit one Registration Form for Company XYZ?

Answer 15:

If the bidders designated in the question as Company A and Company B are wholly owned subsidiaries of Company XYZ, Hydro-Québec Distribution will allow that only one Call for Tenders Registration Form be submitted by said Company XYZ.

However, as indicated in Section 5.1 of the Bid Form, each bidder will be required to describe its ownership Structure, and demonstrate that its parent company is in fact Company XYZ, which submitted the registration form.
