

Question 54: (Translated from French)

Section 2.2.10 of the call for tenders document states that the bidder shall submit an expert opinion confirming the validity of the results obtained and that this expert should have a minimum of five years of experience focused on assessment of wind energy potential and expected electricity generation. Must the expert be independent to the company, that is to say from a third party or can the requested expert advice come from an internal expert of the bidder, who has the five years pertinent experience required?

Answer 54:

The report shall be signed by an internal or independent expert working for the bidder or one of the entities constituting the bidder if that is the case. The expert must meet the requirements mentioned in section 2.2.10 of the call for tenders document for its expertise and experience and must also certify the results of the report by signing it.
