In the case of an Aboriginal project, is there a circumstance under which an Aboriginal nation can hold less than 30 % of the capitalization of the wind farm and/or hold less than 50 % of control of the project and still have the project qualify as valid for the Call for tenders?

Answer 58:

There is no circumstance under which an Aboriginal nation, or any other qualified constituent as defined in Section 1.3.1.1 of the Call for tenders document, can hold less than 30 % of the capitalization or not hold over 50 % of control of the proposed wind farm and still be qualified for the present Call for tenders.
