

TRANSMISSION SERVICE REQUEST

The Cedars Rapids Transmission Company Limited. (CRT) system comprises a double-circuit line operated at 120 kV and linking Les Cèdres substation on the Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie grid to Dennison substation (New York State), the interconnection point on the U.S. border belonging to National Grid. The line section in the U.S. belongs to the Long Sault Division (Long Sault) of Alcoa Power Generating Inc. (APGI). The Cornwall Electric system is connected to the CRT line.

CRT has mandated Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie to market transmission capacity on the CRT system. Customers wishing to make transmission service requests for paths HQT–DEN, DEN–HQT and HQT–CORN must do so using the Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie OASIS site.

To promote intersystem transactions and increase flexibility for deliveries over its system to Canada, CRT has assigned the system's entire transmission capacity to Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie. Through the OASIS site, an integrated reservation service is offered for transmitting power to Cornwall Electric delivery points and Dennison substation, and for transmitting power to the Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie grid from Dennison substation. CRT charges are rolled into the Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie rate.

To facilitate transactions with the New York grid, CRT has reserved all transmission capacity available on the Long Sault system. Since that system is located in the U.S., the reservation rate on it cannot, however, be rolled into the Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie rate. For reservations over paths HQT–DEN and DEN–HQT, there is a US\$1.58/MWh surcharge on top of the applicable Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie rate.

COMMERCIAL ASPECTS:

The customer submitting its first transmission service request must provide Hydro-Québec TransÉnergie with the following information:

- For transmission requests to Canada over the Long Sault system, the Department of Energy (DOE) Docket No. for U.S. exports
- A Resale Certificate (form ST-120) with the Blanket Certificate box checked, exempting CRT from collecting New York State sales tax
