New 315/25-kV substation in the Sud-Ouest borough

Hydro-Québec has begun draft-design studies with a view to building a new 315/25-kV substation in the Sud-Ouest borough's Pointe-Saint-Charles neighborhood.

Due to the growing demand for electricity in the sectors of Griffintown, the port area south of the Canal de Lachine, and Cité-du-Havre, the existing electricity transmission system will reach its maximum capacity in the next few years. The system will also need to power the new Réseau express métropolitain (REM), a light-rail system linking the South Shore with the city centre.

The substation is slated to be built on a lot owned by Hydro-Québec, currently occupied by the Loto-Québec parking lot and the Lafarge cement site, both located on Bridge Street.

Hydro-Québec invites the public to meet with its representatives and learn about the project at an open house meeting to be held on:

in the basement of Saint-Gabriel church 2157 rue Centre

Hydro-Québec representatives will inform residents about the proposed project, answer any questions residents may have and gather their comments.
