Subject: New series of meetings with landowners affected by the Québec–New Hampshire interconnection project

Last December, we sent you a letter to inform you that a new series of meetings with the landowners affected by the project would resume in winter 2017. The objective of these meetings is to discuss easement compensation, and they will be held over several weeks starting in May. A Hydro-Québec representative will get in touch with you to make an appointment.

The Bureau d'audiences publiques sur l'environnement [public environmental hearings board, or BAPE] held a public hearing concerning the project in fall 2016. The BAPE concluded its analysis of the project and submitted a report to the Ministère du Développement durable, de l'Environnement et de la Lutte contre les changements climatiques (MDDELCC). The ministry published the report on February 9, 2017, and made it available for public viewing at http://www.bape.gouv.qc.ca/sections/mandats/ligne_NewHampshire/ (French only). The MDDELCC's environmental analysis is still ongoing, and Hydro-Québec is awaiting a response from the government concerning authorization for the project.
