

Contest Rules
The Électrium: 25 Electrifying Years!

1. The Électrium: 25 Electrifying Years contest (the “contest”) is organized by Hydro-Québec (the “Contest Organizer”). It will run in Québec from 9 a.m. on June 25, 2016, to 5 p.m. on August 25, 2016 (the “contest period”).

ELIGIBILITY

2. The contest is open to:
 - 2.1 Québec residents 18 years of age and older who visit the Électrium, Hydro-Québec’s electricity interpretation centre located at 2001 Rue Michael-Faraday in Sainte-Julie, during the contest period.
 - 2.2 Employees, agents and other representatives of Hydro-Québec and the persons with whom they are domiciled are not eligible.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

3. To enter the contest:
 - 3.1 Entrants must obtain a contest entry form in person at the Électrium located at 2001 Rue Michael-Faraday in Sainte-Julie during the contest period.
 - 3.2 Entrants must duly fill out the contest form, entering their last name, first name, complete address (including postal code), telephone number (including area code), e-mail address and the correct answer to the contest question.
 - 3.3 Entrants must deposit the duly filled out form in the contest box located in the lobby of the Électrium.
 - 3.4 Entrants must be 18 years and older. One (1) entry per person per visit to the Électrium during the contest period.
 - 3.5 Only the entries deposited in the contest box during the contest period are eligible.
 - 3.6 No purchase necessary.

GRAND PRIZE

4. One (1) grand prize will be drawn: a two-day (one night) trip for four (4) people to Radisson, including a chartered round-trip flight between Montréal–Pierre Elliott Trudeau International and La Grande-Rivière airports, one night’s accommodation in two standard rooms (double occupancy) at Auberge Radisson, all meals and guided tours of the Robert-Bourassa hydroelectric development, the La Grande-1 generating station and Robert-A.-Boyd Park, weather permitting. The grand prize is valued at approximately eight thousand nine hundred dollars (\$8,900).

4.1 The following restrictions apply:

- a) All expenses other than those specifically mentioned above shall be assumed by the winner and his/her guests, such as travel between the airport of departure and the winner's and guests' homes, alcoholic beverages, travel documents, insurance, tips, optional excursions (not mentioned above) and personal expenses.
- b) The contest winner and his/her guests must travel on the weekend of September 10–11, 2016. Should the flight to La Grande-Rivière be cancelled prior to departure for reasons that the Contest Organizer could not have foreseen, the Contest Organizer shall inform the winner and propose another weekend in 2017.
- c) The winner and his/her guests shall travel on the same chartered flight.
- d) The guided tours of the Robert-Bourassa hydroelectric development, the La Grande-1 generating station and Robert-A.-Boyd Park will be organized according to a schedule determined by the Contest Organizer. No compensation shall be provided in the event that the tours cannot take place as planned for any reason whatsoever, including bad weather, or if the guests are not present at the agreed-upon time.
- e) The approximate value of the prize is based on the average value of air transport, accommodations and meals, which may vary depending on the date of departure. No compensation shall be paid or be claimed in this regard.

5. The prize may not be exchanged in whole or in part for cash.

AWARDING OF THE GRAND PRIZE

6. At 2 p.m. on Friday, August 26, 2016, in the offices of the Électrium located at 2001 Rue Michael-Faraday in Sainte-Julie and in the presence of at least three (3) witnesses, one (1) entry form will be randomly drawn from all those received during the contest period to award the grand prize described herein.
7. The odds of being randomly selected depend on the number of contest entries at the time of the draw.
8. To be declared the winner and be eligible to receive the grand prize, the entrant whose entry form was randomly drawn shall:
 - 8.1 be notified by telephone or e-mail by the Contest Organizer and claim the grand prize in the two (2) business days following the date on which he/she was notified;
 - 8.2 have correctly answered the question on the entry form.
9. When these conditions are met, the Contest Organizer shall send the winner a confirmation letter or e-mail with information on the awarding of the grand prize.

10. Failure to comply with any of the conditions listed above or any other condition in these contest rules will automatically disqualify the selected entrant, who shall forfeit the prize, which may then be cancelled. The Contest Organizer reserves the right to hold a new random draw from among eligible entries to award the forfeited prize. The same conditions will apply, with any necessary adjustments.
11. The Contest Organizer reserves the right to make any necessary verifications in order to ensure the proper administration of the contest and compliance with these contest rules.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

12. Entry forms are subject to verification by the Contest Organizer. Any incomplete, fraudulent, illegible, mutilated, altered, late or otherwise non-compliant entries may be rejected and shall not qualify for a prize.
13. Any decision by the Contest Organizer or its representatives regarding this contest is final and without appeal, subject to a ruling by the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec on any issue under its jurisdiction.
14. The Contest Organizer reserves the right to disqualify an entrant or cancel one or several entries by anyone who enters or attempts to enter the contest using methods that do not comply with these contest rules or which are unfair to other entrants. Such entrants may be reported to the appropriate legal authorities.
15. The prize must be accepted as described in the contest rules and may be transferred to another adult, but it may not be replaced by another prize or redeemed in whole or in part for cash.
16. The winner and his/her guests shall indemnify and hold harmless the Contest Organizer, its subsidiaries, its advertising and promotional agencies, and their employees, agents and representatives from and against any damages resulting from the acceptance or use of the prize.
17. The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, modify or suspend the contest in whole or in part, or to terminate it, should human intervention or an event take place that could modify or affect the administration, security, impartiality or conduct of the contest as provided in these contest rules, subject to approval by the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec, if applicable.
18. In no event may the Contest Organizer be required to award more prizes than the number stated in these contest rules or award a prize other than in accordance with these contest rules.
19. The winner and his/her guests authorize the Contest Organizer and its representatives to use their names and places of residence, photos, likenesses, statements regarding the prize, or voices for publicity purposes, without any form of compensation.

20. This contest is subject to all applicable laws and regulations. Any dispute regarding the organization or conduct of a promotional contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. Any dispute regarding the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Régie only for the purpose of attempting to settle it.

24. Should any section of these rules be declared or deemed illegal, unenforceable or invalid by a competent court, the section shall be considered invalid, but all unaffected sections will be applied within the limits of the law.
