

"Moving? Get Online!" Contest Rules

1. The "Moving? Get Online!" contest is being held by Hydro-Québec (the "Contest Organizer"). The contest will run in Québec from May 5, 2008, until 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time on June 30, 2008 (the "Contest Period").

ELIGIBILITY

2. The contest is open to Québec residents 18 years of age or over at the time of entering who hold a Hydro-Québec residential account ("the Eligible Account") throughout the contest period and on 2:00 p.m. EST on August 7, 2008. Employees, agents and representatives of the Contest Organizer, its subsidiaries, its advertising and promotional agencies, and the suppliers of products, services and equipment related to this contest as well as their immediate families (brothers, sisters, children, fathers, mothers), their legal or common-law spouses and members of their households are not eligible. Also excluded are commercial and small business customers who hold an account at the residential rate.

HOW TO ENTER

No purchase necessary.

Basic entry – Moving/Change of address

3. During the Contest Period, go to www.hydroquebec.com/moving and notify Hydro-Québec of your upcoming move through our Web site. To enter the contest automatically, simply do one of the following:
 - 3.1 Notify us of your upcoming move
 - 3.2 Request an electrical service contract for a new residential address
 - 3.3 Terminate a service contract if you have more than one
 - 3.4 Become a new customer and request a new service contract.

Completing one of the above transactions online during the contest period entitles you to one basic contest entry.

Additional entries – Online Billing*

4. Once you have notified us of your move through one of the actions listed above, you can triple your chances of winning by adding Hydro-Québec's Online Billing service to your Personal Page during the contest period. Doing so entitles you to two additional contest entries. It is not necessary to sign up for Online Billing at the same time as you notify us of your move, as long as you do it sometime during the contest period. To sign up for Online Billing,** simply proceed as follows:
 - 4.1 If you already have a Personal Page:
 - Log on to your Personal Page

- Click on “Sign up for Online Billing” in your Personal Page and follow the on-screen instructions.

4.2 If you do not have a Personal Page:

- Go to www.hydroquebec.com/moving
- Create your Personal Page by clicking “Create my page.” Follow the on-screen instructions and complete the electronic form (you should have an electricity bill on hand from 2008, including the detachable portion).
- Click on “Sign up for Online Billing” in your Personal Page and follow the on-screen instructions.

4.3 Signing up to receive your Hydro-Québec bill through epost™ does not entitle you to two additional entries.

4.4 If you are a new customer, you must wait to receive your account number, which you will need to create your Personal Page and sign up for Online Billing.

* This section does not apply to new customers, who must wait to receive a bill, since a bill is needed to sign up for Online Billing. Signing up for billing through epost™ does not entitle you to two additional entries.

** You must have Internet access and a valid e-mail address to subscribe to Online Billing.

Signing up through Customer Services

5. As part of a pilot project, some customers who contact Customer Services to notify us of their move may be offered, on a random basis, the option of setting up a Personal Page, or using their existing one, to complete the notification of their move online with the representative. Customers who accept will automatically be entered in the contest. At the same time, the representative will also encourage customers to sign up for Online Billing and triple their chances of winning.

To sign up through Customer Services, you must have Internet access and a valid e-mail address.

No purchase necessary.

6. If you do not hold a residential account with Hydro-Québec or if during the Contest Period your account is terminated, you may still enter in the contest by sending an original and handwritten letter of at least 50 words explaining why you would like to win one of the prizes. Print, legibly, your name, age, full address (including your postal code), telephone number (including the area code) and e-mail address. Sign and mail your letter with the appropriate postage to: “Moving? Get Online, no purchase required” Contest - c/o Mr. Jeff MacDonald, at 2 Complexe Desjardins, tour Est, 26^e étage, Montréal (Québec) H5B 1H7, no later than June 30, 2008. Letters postmarked later than this date will be declared invalid.

On receipt, your letter will be validated by the Contest Organizer's representatives and you will automatically receive one (1) basic contest entry. Only winning contest entrants will be contacted.

7. Limits. Contest entrants must comply with the following limits, failing which they could be disqualified:

7.1 One (1) basic contest entry per customer during the Contest Period for Moving/Change of address

7.2 Two (2) additional entries per customer during the Contest Period for Online Billing

7.3 One (1) mail-in entry per household during the Contest Period

PRIZES

Grand prizes

8. Two (2) grand prizes are offered. Each grand prize consists of one (1) MacBook Air laptop with a SuperDrive, having an approximate retail value of two thousand dollars (\$2, 000). The color is at the discretion of the Contest Organizer.

Secondary prizes

9. Ten (10) second prizes are offered. Each second prize consists of one (1) iPod 32GB touch device with an approximate retail value of five hundred and twenty dollars (\$520). The color is at the discretion of the Contest Organizer.

Draw

10. On August 7, 2008, at 2:00 p.m. Eastern Time, in the offices of the Contest Organizer located at 2 Complexe Desjardins, East Tower, 26th Floor, Montréal, twelve (12) eligible entries will be drawn electronically from all entries collected in compliance with these rules throughout the Contest Period. The grand prizes and second prizes will be awarded in the order in which they are described in paragraphs 7 and 8.

11. Odds of winning. The odds of drawing an entry submitted by a contest entrant depend on the total number of entries collected during the Contest Period. An entrant has up to three (3) chances of winning a prize.

12. Limit. There is a limit of one prize per person and per household.

AWARDING OF PRIZES

- 13.** To be declared a winner, any participant whose name is randomly drawn must:
- 13.1 be reached by telephone or e-mail by the Contest Organizer within ten (10) business days of the draw;
 - 13.2 complete and sign the declaration and release form (the “Declaration Form”) sent by the Contest Organizer and return it to the Contest Organizer within fifteen (15) business days of receiving it; and
 - 13.3 correctly answer the mathematical skill-testing question on the entry form.
- 14.** Any winner who fails to comply with any of the conditions in these contest rules will automatically be disqualified and will not collect the prize. In such a case, the Contest Organizer reserves the right to hold a new draw for this prize from among the remaining entries, excluding those already selected for a prize. The same conditions will still apply, with the method for awarding the prize amended as necessary. Similarly, if a winner rejects a prize, the Contest Organizer may at its sole discretion hold a new draw for this prize until an entry is selected and the entrant declared the winner. If no winner is identified for a prize within sixty (60) days of the original draw, the Contest Organizer may cancel this prize at its sole discretion. No compensation or other form of indemnification will be granted.
- 15.** Each winner will receive his or her prize within six (6) to eight (8) weeks after the duly completely and signed Declaration Form is received.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 16.** Electronic entries, letters and Declaration Forms are subject to verification by the Contest Organizer. Any electronic entry, letter or Declaration Form that is incomplete, fraudulent, altered, late, illegible or is otherwise noncompliant and, in the case of the Declaration Form, does not have the correct answer to the mathematical skill-testing question, will be rejected and will not entitle the entrant to an entry or, if applicable, to the prize.
- 17.** The Contest Organizer reserves the right to disqualify any entrant or cancel one or more entries by anyone who enters or attempts to enter this contest using methods that do not comply with these contest rules or that are unfair to the other entrants (for example: plagiarism, participation that exceeds the limit, piracy, etc.). Such an entrant may be reported to the appropriate authorities.
- 18.** Any decision by the Contest Organizer or its representatives regarding this contest is final and without appeal, subject to a ruling by the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec on any issue under its jurisdiction.
- 19.** By participating in the contest, any entrant selected to win a prize indemnifies and holds harmless the Contest Organizer, its subsidiaries, its advertising and promotional agencies, and their employees, agents and representatives, from any liability for damage resulting from the acceptance or use of the prize. To be declared a winner and prior to accepting a prize, the selected entrant must sign a statement to that effect on the Declaration Form.

20. The winners also recognize that the only warranty applicable to the prizes is the one offered by the manufacturer, and they release Hydro-Québec from any responsibility in this regard. To be declared a winner and prior to accepting a prize, the selected entrant must sign a statement to that effect on the Declaration Form.
21. Prizes must be accepted as described in these contest rules and may not be transferred, replaced by another prize or exchanged in whole or in part for cash, except as provided in the section below.
22. In the event that, for reasons unrelated to the winners, it is impossible, difficult and/or more costly for the Contest Organizer to award a prize as described in these contest rules, the Contest Organizer reserves the right to replace the prize with one of the same kind and of equivalent value or, at its sole discretion, with the cash value of the prize as indicated in the contest rules.
23. The Contest Organizer, its affiliates, its advertising and promotional agencies, and their employees, agents and representatives disclaim all liability for the malfunctioning of any computer component, software or communications line, for the loss or lack of a communications network or for any transmission that is faulty, incomplete, incomprehensible or erased by any computer or network, and that may limit or prevent any entrant's participation in the contest. The Contest Organizer, its affiliates, its advertising and promotional agencies, and their employees, agents and representatives also disclaim all liability for any damage or loss that may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by the downloading of any Web page, software or other element, or by the transmission of any information for purposes of the contest.
24. The Contest Organizer in no way guarantees that the contest Web site will be accessible or functional without interruption during the Contest Period or that it will be free of any errors. In the event the computer system is unable to record all contest entries at any time during the Contest Period and for any reason, the Contest Organizer cannot be held responsible. In all cases, the prizes will be awarded from among the entries registered in the computer system.
25. The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, modify or suspend this contest in whole or in part, or to terminate it, should human intervention or an event take place that could modify or affect the administration, security, impartiality or conducting of the contest as provided in these contest rules, subject to approval by the Régie des alcools, des courses et de jeux du Québec, if applicable.
26. Should participation in the contest have to be stopped, in whole or in part, prior to the closing date stated in these contest rules, the draw may be held, at the discretion of the Contest Organizer, from among entries duly registered between the start of the contest and the date of the event that put an end to contest participation.
27. In no event shall the Contest Organizer, its affiliates, its advertising and promotional agencies, or their employees, agents and representatives be required to award more prizes than the number stated in these contest rules, or award a prize other than in accordance with these contest rules.

28. Entrants who participate or try to participate in this contest release the Contest Organizer, its subsidiaries, its advertising and promotional agencies and their employees, agents and representatives from any liability for damages that such entrants may incur as a result of their participation or attempt to participate in the contest.
29. Each entrant selected to win a prize authorizes the Contest Organizer and its representatives to use, if required, his or her name, photo, likeness, statements regarding the prize, place of residence and/or voice for publicity purposes, without any form of compensation. Winners shall sign a statement to this effect on the Declaration Form.
30. Any attempt to deliberately damage the contest Web site and/or any associated site or to undermine the legitimate conduct of the contest constitutes a violation of civil and criminal laws. In the event of any such attempt, the Contest Organizer reserves the right to reject the entries of the person in question and to seek redress as provided by law.
31. For the purpose of these contest rules, the entrant is the person whose name, address and telephone number are shown on the electronic entry or letter. This is the person to whom the prize will be awarded if declared the winner.
32. This contest is subject to all applicable laws and regulations. Any dispute regarding the organization or conducting of a promotional contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. Any dispute regarding the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Régie for the sole purpose of settling the dispute.
33. No communication or correspondence shall be exchanged with contest entrants other than in compliance with these contest rules or as initiated by the Contest Organizer.
34. Personal information gathered about entrants for this contest shall be used only for the administration of this contest. No literature, promotional or other, that is unrelated to this contest shall be sent to entrants unless they specifically authorize it.
35. If any section of the contest rules is declared or deemed illegal, unenforceable or invalid by a competent court, that section shall be considered invalid, but all unaffected sections will be applied within the limits of the law.
