Safety Measure at the Waskaganish Drinking Water Treatment Plant

Nemiscau workcamp, Wednesday, November 18

On November 17, we were informed that the ecological instream flow from the Rivière Rupert had been increased from 127 to 400 cubic metres per second for an indeterminate period.

It may take a few days for the effects of the increased flow to be felt at the mouth of the Rupert at Waskaganish.

The river's present flow is sufficient for the normal operation of the Waskaganish drinking water treatment plant. However, as a safety measure, a pump will be installed near the plant so that the intake can be supplied with additional water, if needed.
