PARTIAL DIVERSION OF THE RIVIÈRE RUPERT – NOVEMBER 7, 2009

Nemiscau workcamp, November 2, 2009

The Société d'énergie de la Baie James (SEBJ) would like to inform all land users that the partial diversion of the Rivière Rupert will take place on November 7. The partial diversion marks the beginning of impoundment of the Rupert diversion bays and of the reduction in flow in the lower Rivière Rupert, from the dam to the river mouth at Waskaganish. Note that the mean annual flows of the Rivière Lemare and Rivière Nemiscau will remain unchanged.

Throughout the coming winter, SEBJ discourages snowmobilers from venturing onto the ice cover in the Rupert diversion bays. SEBJ also recommends that users exercise caution in the downstream section.
