HIGHLIGHTS

MEETING 1 – REGIONAL TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

- The regional technical committee (RTC) met on December 12, 2013.

- The committee is made up of land use, environment, landscape and engineering specialists, mandated by the affected municipal authorities (municipalities and regional county municipalities), the Conférence régionale des élus des Laurentides – Projet Paysages Laurentides, the Conseil régional de l’environnement des Laurentides and Hydro-Québec.

- The committee members agree that the project is required.

- The committee members agreed on the RTC’s mandate, operating procedures and work plan.

- The mandate adopted by the members was defined as follows:
 - Examine scenarios for meeting the growing demand in the regional county municipalities (MRCs) of Pays-d’en-Haut and Laurentides.
 - Recommend one or several solutions involving a project with minimal impact that reconciles the interests, concerns and needs of the different stakeholders.
 - Submit conclusions to the organizations represented within the committee.
