## 120-kV GRAND-BRÛLÉ–SAINT-SAUVEUR SUPPLY LINE PROJECT

### HIGHLIGHTS

#### MEETING 3 – REGIONAL TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

- The regional technical committee (RTC) met on February 6, 2014.
- The committee agreed that the facilitator will be the spokesperson for the regional technical committee.
- Hydro-Québec presented the supply scenarios studied for this 120-kV line project, including the ones that had been requested by the community. This document will be given to the committee members.
- The municipality of Saint-Adolphe-d'Howard and the consulting engineer it mandated briefly presented the scenarios they studied. The study will be given to the committee members.
- The members agreed that Hydro-Québec's technical experts (planning and environment) and the consulting engineer mandated by the municipality of Saint-Adolphe-d'Howard will work together to determine criteria for comparing the scenarios presented at this third meeting. Based on these criteria, they will create an analysis grid for the scenarios, which will be presented at the next meeting.
- Hydro-Québec will present its regional planning for the Laurentides power transmission system at the next meeting.
- The next meeting will be held on February 27.
