## 120-kV GRAND-BRÛLÉ–SAINT-SAUVEUR SUPPLY LINE PROJECT

### HIGHLIGHTS

#### MEETING 4 – REGIONAL TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

---

- The regional technical committee (RTC) met on March 20, 2014.
- Hydro-Québec presented the power transmission system planning for the Laurentides and Lanaudière regions. This presentation is available on Hydro-Québec's Web site at: [www.hydroquebec.com/projects/planification-laurentides.html](http://www.hydroquebec.com/projects/planification-laurentides.html)
- The technical sub-committee made up of experts from Hydro-Québec and from the municipality of Saint-Adolphe-d'Howard submitted and presented the comparative analysis grid that it produced. This document compares the different supply scenarios studied from technical and economic standpoints.
- Based on the technical sub-committee's grid, the RTC decided to retain 3 of the 10 scenarios presented.
- Hydro-Québec's environment specialist submitted and presented a summary assessment of the environmental impact of each of the supply scenarios studied by the sub-committee.
- The committee members agreed to revise the list of environmental criteria and to form a sub-committee of environment specialists (human environment, biophysical environment and landscape) made up of representatives from both regional county municipalities, the Conférence régionale des élus des Laurentides, the Conseil régional de l'environnement des Laurentides and two specialists from Hydro-Québec. This sub-committee's mandate will be to submit an improved list of criteria to the RTC members and to produce a comparative analysis of the environmental impact of the three supply scenarios selected.
- The next regional technical committee meeting will be held on April 24.
