HIGHLIGHTS
MEETING 8 – SEPTEMBER 4, 2014
REGIONAL TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

- The regional technical committee (RTC) met on September 4, 2014.
- Regarding the project's media coverage, the committee's procedures were reviewed to make sure they were adhered to by committee members.
- Regarding the mandate of the technical committee, members consider that it is not their role to analyze the feasibility or the relevance of the BAPE holding hearings on the project.
- Hydro-Québec presented an updated preliminary map of the biophysical and human environment as well as the landscape map of the study area.
- Hydro-Québec then presented the initial optimizations made to the route located in the central reference axis. These optimizations will be subject to more detailed work.
- Committee members noted the improvements made to the project since the original route was presented.
- Hydro-Québec committed to carrying out other simulations and integrating the data supplied by the municipality of Saint-Adolphe-d'Howard.
- Members of the RTC will be sent the document containing the questions, comments and specifics about the environmental analysis grid at a regional scale. Given the lack of time, discussing this point is postponed until the next meeting.
- At the next meeting, committee members wish to outline their future commitments in relation to the process.
- The next meeting of the RTC will be held on October 15, 2014.
