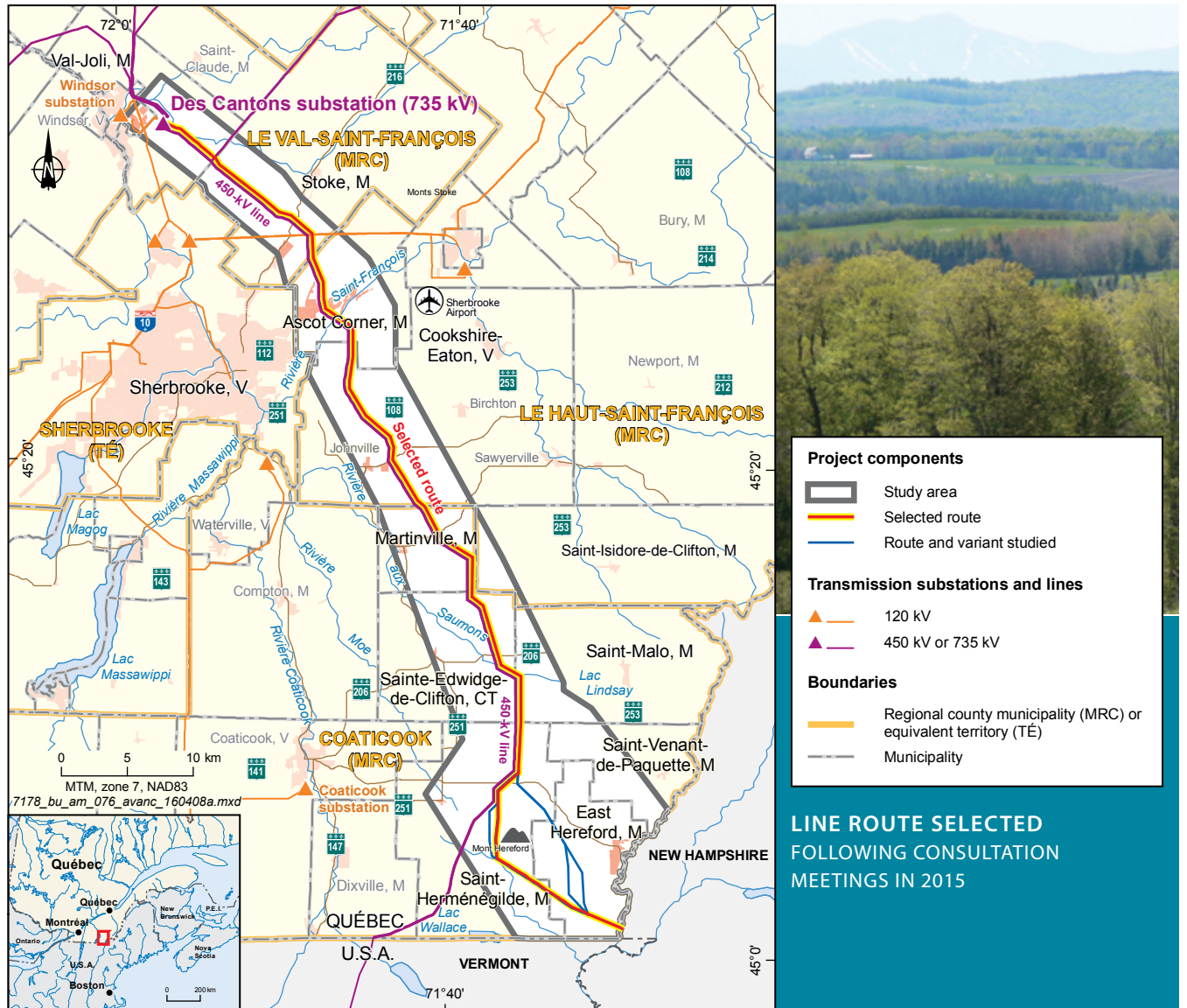


QUÉBEC-NEW HAMPSHIRE INTERCONNECTION

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project involves the construction of a 320-kV* direct-current transmission line, about 80 km long, in Québec. This line will be extended into the U.S.A. and will connect Des Cantons substation in Val-Joli to Franklin substation in southern New Hampshire.



* kV = kilovolt, or 1,000 volts.
