Re: Request for Access to information C-6543

Dear Sir:

We are writing in response to your request for access to information received on January 14th, 2019 in which you have requested the following:

"Copy of the following document(s): Generator Energy Output and Capability Report, which is the energy output and capability for generating facilities Hydro-Québec-administered energy market. We are looking for hourly data, but daily is useful as well."

In a following email to Sébastien Dutil, conseiller - Accès à l'information you added that:

"I'm looking at all Hydro Quebec wind facilities, with individual numbers for each facility. The time period I'm looking for is hourly data from October, 1 2013-Dec 31 2018."

First of all, note that Hydro-Québec does not own any wind facilities, we purchase wind power energy from third parties following request for proposals.

In reply to your request, the total contractual energy capacity of our suppliers is 3 667,75 MW (in service). Note that no English translation of these documents is available.

Unfortunately, as for the wind generation forecasts, we are unable to provide you with the documents you request because they contain information of a commercial nature that is considered confidential. This is outlined in sections 21 and 22 of the *Act respecting access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information*.

As for the actual output of the wind facilities, we are unable to provide you with these because they contain third party information of a commercial nature that is considered confidential. This is outlined in sections 23 and 24 of the *Act respecting access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information*.

An application for review of this decision may be submitted to the Commission d'accès à l'information. A note outlining the process is enclosed.
