
Dismantling of the 120-kV Beauharnois-Aqueduc Line

Châteauguay segment

June 2020



Project description

Hydro-Québec will dismantle a 120-kilovolt (kV) transmission line, as set out in our agreement with the Kahnawake Band Council.

This line, which runs through Mohawk territory, carries electricity from Beauharnois generating station to Aqueduc substation, in Montréal's LaSalle borough. Dismantling is possible thanks to the presence of a 315-kV line in the area and to the conversion of Montréal's power system to this voltage.

Description of the work in Châteauguay

The total project involves the removal of the conductors and the dismantling of 131 towers, including 44 in Châteauguay, spread out over 20 km.

Work schedule

- Phase 1: dismantling of conductors
Fall 2020 – winter 2021
- Phase 2: dismantling of towers
2022

Information will be sent out during the work to keep the community updated on the project's progress.

Mitigation measures

- Work will be carried out in compliance with environmental standards in effect.
- Hydro-Québec will work with municipal authorities on a traffic management plan to minimize inconveniences to drivers, cyclists and pedestrians
- Access to residences will be maintained.
