

Dismantling of the 120-kV Beauharnois–Aqueduc line – Châteauguay segment

November 2020

The work to dismantle the Beauharnois–Aqueduc line is scheduled to begin on November 10, 2020.

Description of the work

The first stage of the project involves three steps to dismantle the conductors:

1. Preparatory work and securement of the right-of-way
2. Installation of the blocks and winches
3. Removal of the conductors

Impact of the work

To ensure public safety, we must secure the work zone and limit access to the roads, bicycle paths, parking lots and land located in the line right-of-way for a period of up to three days.

Project schedule (see map on reverse)

Phase 1: Between Boulevard Maple and Kahnawake – **Fall 2020**

Phase 2: Between Highway 30 and Boulevard Maple – **Winter 2021**



Mitigation measures

We are sensitive to the inconvenience the project may cause and will implement all possible measures to minimize the impacts:

- A traffic management plan has been developed in collaboration with municipal authorities to facilitate access for drivers, cyclists and pedestrians.
- Detours are planned, and the work will take place outside peak traffic hours.
- Access to residences will be maintained, subject to exceptions.
- Work will be carried out in compliance with current environmental standards.
