Bridge refurbishment at Beauharnois

Melocheville and downtown Beauharnois areas

Hydro-Québec must proceed with refurbishing the bridge at Beauharnois, located on Route 132, downstream of the generating station. In service since 1949, the bridge provides a link for vehicle, bicycle and pedestrian traffic between Melocheville and downtown Beauharnois.

The bridge is in need of major repairs, as it has reached an advanced stage in its life cycle and the last major work dates back to 2014.

Objectives of the work

1. Ensure the safety of bridge users
2. Maintain road system reliability

Mitigation measures

Our goal is to minimize disruption to local activities.

Mitigation measures will be implemented to reduce the duration of nuisances related to noise and lighting at the worksite.



Partial and full closures

The work will be carried out in several phases between 2026 and 2028 and will result, depending on the progress of the work, in partial and full closures of the bridge (see over for more information).

Users are encouraged to consult the traffic disruption schedule regularly, take note of the detours and plan their travel accordingly (see over).

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Traffic disruption schedule

- October 2026 to April 2027: Partially open to traffic
- April to December 2027: **Closed to traffic**
- December 2027: Partially open to traffic
- January 2027 to March 2028: **Open to traffic**
- March to June 2028: Partially open to traffic
- June to July 2028: **Closed to traffic (for 3 weeks)**
- July to August 2028: Partially open to traffic

To make it easier to get around during road closures, detours will be set up and clearly marked.
