Upgrades to the underground power distribution system in the Chemin Merrimac (Meadows complex) area

Phase 2 – Spring/summer 2026

Hydro-Québec is continuing to upgrade the underground power distribution system in the Chemin Merrimac area. The work involves replacing the underground distribution system supplying the Meadows complex, as it has reached the end of its service life.

The system upgrade, planned to be conducted in several phases, will improve service quality for the residents of the complex.

Please note that no service interruptions are anticipated as part of this work.

Description of the work

The second phase of the work consists of replacing underground duct banks located in front of and behind the homes near the JPPS-Bialik school.

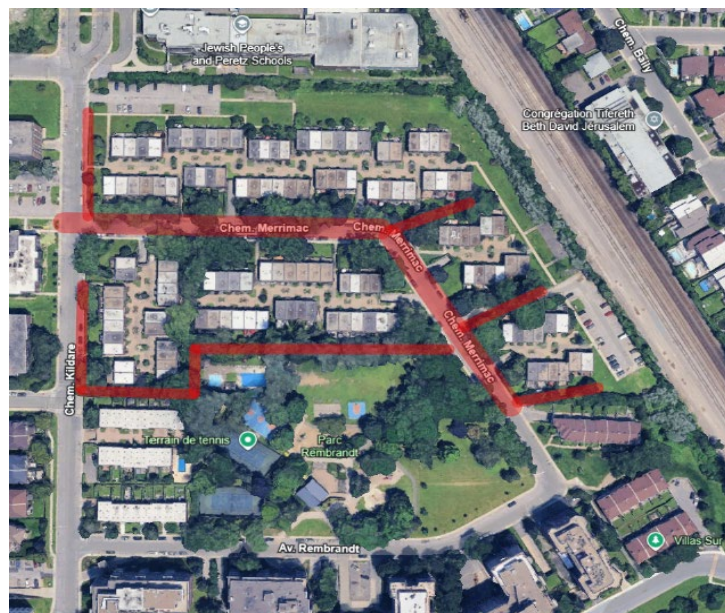
A trench, approximately one-metre deep, will be dug in the public right-of-way and on private land and then the new duct banks will be installed. The electrical cables will be placed inside the ducts at a later date. The backfilling of the trench will be done as work progresses.

Project schedule

The second phase of the work will be carried out from **April 15 to August 28, 2026**, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Work area

The work area is located near the homes in the Meadows complex and the JPPS-Bialik school.

Phase 2 – Summer 2026

Impact of the work

- A portion of the sidewalk on Rue Kildare will be closed to foot traffic.
- Access will be maintained for vehicle traffic.
- The work will cause dust as well as noise from machinery.



Rebuilding the underground power system

Mitigation measures

- A safe pedestrian passage will be established on Chemin Merrimac.
- Homes will remain accessible at all times.
- No service interruption is anticipated during the work.
- When the work is completed, Hydro-Québec will restore the site.

Parking and parking stickers

Chemin Merrimac will remain open to two-way traffic. However, parking will be prohibited during the work. Access to the underground parking lot will be maintained at all times, except during temporary disruptions. Details regarding dates, work duration and planned mitigation measures will be shared in advance with the residents concerned.

Next steps

This is the last phase in the civil engineering work. The electrical engineering work will be carried out next.
