Construction of an underground 315-kV transmission line between Guy and Des Irlandais substations

Work planned for May to October 2026

To meet growing demand for electricity and ensure the long-term operability of its facilities on the island of Montréal, Hydro-Québec is building an underground transmission line between Guy substation and the new Des Irlandais substation.

Description of the work

Major work to build the underground concrete duct banks and rebuild the roadway will take place on **Saint-Patrick, Bridge, Mill** and **Wellington**. Traffic on the **Victoria Bridge** will be **limited to one lane in both directions during morning rush hour**.

This work will be carried out in several successive phases to keep impacts to a minimum. However, temporary disruptions to traffic and certain access points should still be expected.

From late May until mid-October, depending on work progress, the following areas will be affected:

- **Saint-Patrick/Bridge intersection**
- **Rue Bridge (between Saint-Patrick and Wellington)**
- **Wellington/Bridge intersection**
- **Rue Bridge (between Wellington and Mill)**
- **Rue Bridge (between Mill and Costco entrance)**

Work impacts:

- **Beginning in August, traffic limited to one lane in both directions on the Victoria Bridge during morning rush hour**
- **Temporary disruptions** on Saint-Patrick, Bridge, Mill and Wellington
- **Full or partial closure of certain intersections** as work progresses
- Temporary adjustments to **traffic lights**
- **Possible impacts on public transit, including STM bus routes 61 and 74**

Mitigation measures:

- **Safety and mobility will be ensured through the posting of signage and ongoing monitoring.**
- **Detours via de Condé and Centre are planned and will be clearly marked.**
- To facilitate construction site access, **trucks will be temporarily permitted on Charlevoix and Centre.**
- In cooperation with **the STM, bus routes 61 and 74 will be adjusted** to ensure service continuity.

Note: No service interruptions are anticipated at either of the two stages of work planned.

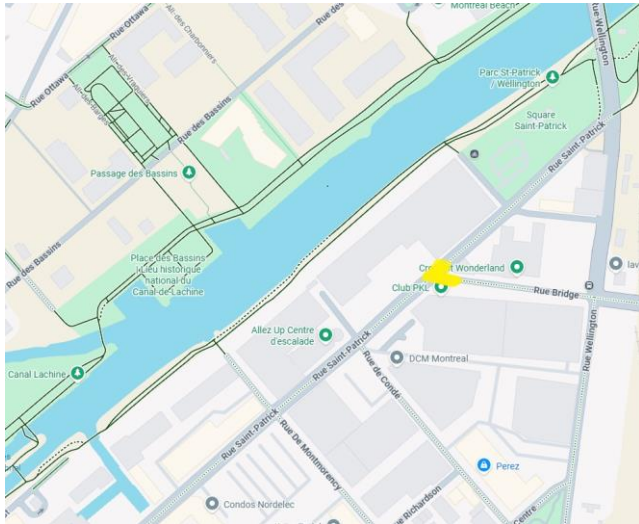

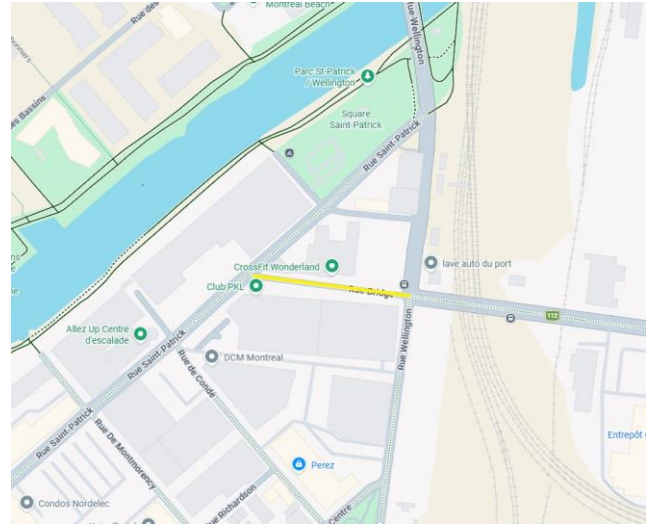

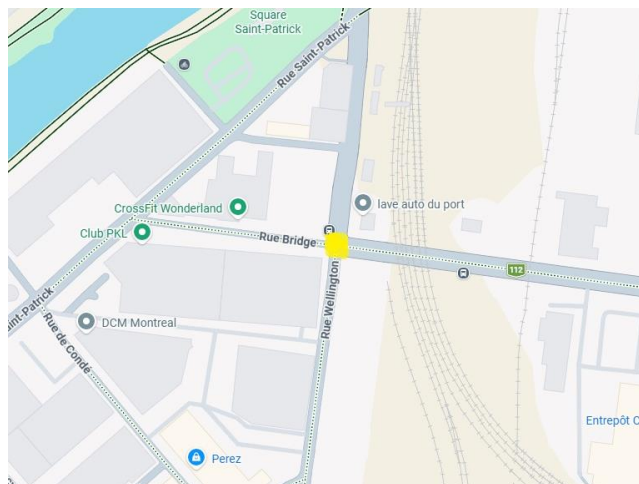
May 25 to June 26, 2026: Rue Bridge (between Saint-Patrick and Wellington)



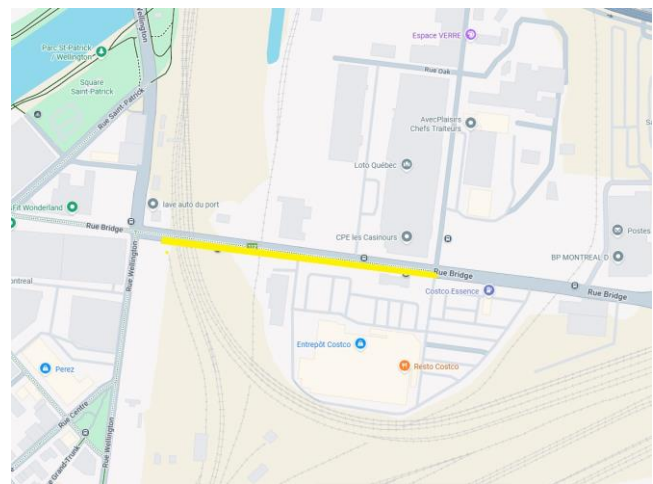
June 5 to 22, 2026: Saint-Patrick/Bridge intersection

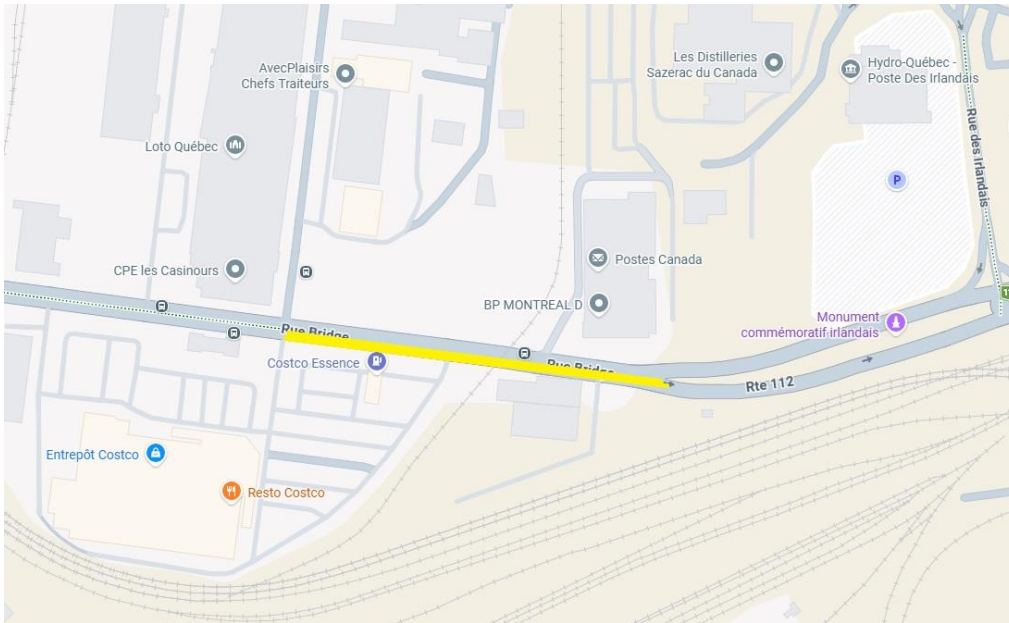
