Reconstruction of electrical facilities on Chemin Heywood and Boulevard Cavendish
Spring 2026

Hydro-Québec is about to complete the reconstruction of electrical installations on Chemin Heywood in Côte-Saint-Luc, near Boulevard Cavendish.

The work period, which was originally scheduled to end in December 2025, had to be extended in order to ensure workers' safety.

Because there are live cables in the conduits, we will have to work more slowly than originally planned, which will prolong the duration of the project.

Work schedule

Work will be carried out Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Work is scheduled to be completed by May 22.

Type of work and location

The project involves rebuilding two underground vaults and the construction of new conduits to house electrical cables.

Work will take place on Chemin Heywood, between Boulevard Cavendish and 6823 Chemin Heywood.

Other upcoming work

Please note that additional work is planned on Chemin Heywood. This will involve building a conduit under Chemin Heywood to house electrical cables, which will supply power to nearby residences.

This two-week project will take place during the summer to minimize the impact on residents and students attending the nearby school.
