Upgrades to the underground power distribution system in the Chemin Merrimac (Meadows complex) area

Phase 1 – Fall 2025

Hydro-Québec is carrying out upgrades to the underground power distribution system in the Chemin Merrimac (Meadows complex) area. The work involves replacing the underground distribution system supplying Meadows condominiums, as it has reached the end of its service life.

This system upgrade, planned to be conducted in several phases, will improve service quality for the residents of the complex connected to the new system.

Please note that no service interruptions are anticipated as part of this work.

Description of the work

This first phase of work consists of replacing the underground pipes located behind the residences, near the Bialik school.

A trench, approximately one-metre deep, will be dug in the public right-of-way and on private land and then the duct banks will be installed. The electrical cables will be placed inside the ducts at a later date. The backfilling of the trench will be done as work progresses.

Work schedule

The first phase of the work is planned from **November 17 to December 12, 2025**, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. The other phases of the work are scheduled for 2026.

Work area

The work zone is located near the Meadows complex residences and the Bialik school.

Phase 1 – Fall 2025

Impacts of the work

- A portion of the sidewalk on Rue Kildare will be closed to foot traffic.
- The private, outdoor parking lot will be inaccessible during the work (four weeks).
- The work will cause dust as well as noise from machinery.

Mitigation measures

- A safe pedestrian passage will be established.
- Homes will remain accessible at all times.
- No service interruptions are anticipated as part of the work.
- Hydro-Québec will restore the site to its initial state once the work has been completed.

Parking and parking stickers

During the work, the parking lot located near Rue Marc-Chagall will be closed on certain occasions.

During the day, property owners will have to park their cars in the street in accordance with the signage.

During the night, parking a vehicle on the street between 3 a.m. and 6 a.m. is prohibited.

Residents who wish to park a vehicle on the street overnight must contact the city of Côte-Saint-Luc to obtain a temporary parking permit.
