Responses to comments received during the third consultation period**

This document provides a summary of the comments presented by the entities, as they were received and in the language used by them during the third consultation period concerning Project QC-2012-01.

The comments from Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("NLH") were presented in English.

Register of Entites		With respect to the Register of Entities, NLH ask that the RC include in the footnote of each page, the date of the Register, as was the case in previous versions. In addition, section 4 of the Register makes reference to a July 11th 2013 version of the Registry, which we assume will be approved with the final decision in R-3699-2009 (phase 1), and which we were not been able to find in the current documentation provided by RC.	NLH	Partially	In order to avoid editing the entire document when only minor modifications are needed, the Reliability Coordinator withdrew the date on each page of the Register. The Reliability Coordinator considers that the date on the cover page of the document clearly indicates the version. The version 2013-07-11 indicated in the version history of the Register has never been filed with the Régie therefore, this version does not exist. However, this modification has been included in the Register. This change should rather be indicated for the proposed version 2014-04-24 which is part of this consultation period. The Reliability Coordinator will correct this error before filing with the Régie de l'énergie. Please note that the modification only affects the confidential version of the Register and only concerns assets owned by Hydro-Québec.
