

Notice of Consultation Project QC-2014-01

In accordance with the decision [D-2011-139](#) of the Régie de l'énergie of Québec, the Reliability Coordinator of Québec is soliciting comments from the registered entities on the following reliability standards and documents in view of their submittal to the Régie de l'énergie of Québec for adoption or approval, depending on the nature of the documents.

Notice addressed to:

- Entities listed in the register of entities;
- The North American Electric Reliability Corporation, inc. (NERC);
- The Northeast Power Coordinating Council, inc. (NPCC);
- The NPCC Reliability Coordinators;
- The Régie de l'énergie du Québec.

Documents and standards under consultation:

In accordance with the decision [D-2014-048](#), the Reliability Coordinator is launching a public consultation on the following standards:

- EOP-005-2 – System Restoration from Blackstart Resources
- EOP-006-2 – System Restoration Coordination
- EOP-008-1 – Loss of Control Center Functionality
- IRO-005-3.1a – Reliability Coordination – Current Day Operations
- MOD-004-1 – Capacity Benefit Margin
- PER-003-1 – Operating Personnel Credentials

Each standard or group of standards is accompanied by an informational document comprised of the following elements:

- A preliminary assessment of the relevance and impact of the proposed standard;
- Modifications to other standards or to the glossary;
- Proposed effective dates

Consultation Period: May 15, 2014 to June 12, 2014.

Documents must be received no later than June 12, 2014 at 23:59.

Comments

The Reliability Coordinator solicits feedback on the standards, appendices of these standards, the preliminary assessment of relevance and impact, and on modifications to the glossary of terms. Similarly, the Reliability Coordinator shall submit to the Régie de l'énergie an assessment of the impact of the proposed standards on the registered entities. In order to achieve this, for each reliability standard that has an impact on your company and its operations, please fill out the form intended for this purpose available online on the consultation page of the Reliability Coordinator's website. The accuracy of the filing that the Coordinator shall submit to the Régie relies on your input.
