In accordance with the Régie de l'énergie du Québec's decision [D-2011-139](#), the Reliability Coordinator for Québec (the "Reliability Coordinator") is soliciting comments from registered entities and stakeholders on reliability standards and other documents to be filed with the Régie de l'énergie du Québec for adoption or approval, depending on the nature of each document.

### Documents submitted for consultation

The purpose of the current public consultation is to harmonize the reliability regimes in Québec and the United States. The Coordinator presents five new standards, one new definition and a modified definition. Details of these standards can be found in the supporting document that accompanies each standard. In addition, the Coordinator proposes the withdrawal of a standard.

- New standards or versions :
  - EOP-011-1 – Emergency Operations;
  - MOD-031-2 – Demand and Energy Data;
  - PRC-004-5(i) – Protection Systems Misoperation Identification and Correction;
  - PRC-010-2 – Under Voltage Load Shedding;
  - PRC-026-1 – Relay Performance During Stable Power Swings;
- Addition of the "UVLS Program" definition;
- Modification to the "Energy Emergency" definition;

The Reliability Coordinator solicits your feedback on the reliability standards and the proposed new definition for the Glossary of Terms and Acronyms used in the Reliability Standards (Glossary).
